All Architecture, Inc.

Majed M. Hawari

Case Nos. 2010-053536 & 2012-009901

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$5,000.00 plus costs against All Architecture, Inc. and Majed M. Hawari. All Architecture, Inc. and Majed M. Hawari are not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and provided architectural services on a commercial project. Further, Mr. Hawari is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Tony K. Cheung

Case No. 2011-039635

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing Tony K. Cheung's Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Cheung signed and sealed engineering drawings that were not incidental to his architectural work. Further, the drawings were deficient and did not have the proper title block.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs against Corner Stone Design Group, Inc. and Edward P. Tafelski are not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and was paid directly by the client for providing design services on a commercial project. Further, Mr. Tafelski is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization

Case No. 2011-010709

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs against Thomas L. Hanson and TL Hanson & Associates Consulting Engineers, Inc. Mr. Hanson is a licensed Professional Engineer and was paid by an unlicensed firm to sign and seal drawings for a commercial project.

The Kirouac Group

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$2,500.00 plus costs against The Kirouac Group and Shawn Kirouac. The Kirouac Group, Inc. and Shawn Kirouac are not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and entered into a contract to provide architectural services for a residence, medical facility, walk in clinic and The Savannah Grand. Further, Mr. Kirouac is offering these services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization.

Looney & Associates, LLC

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$2,500.00 plus costs against Looney & Associates, LLC and James Looney. Looney & Associates, LLC and James Looney are not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and are offering and providing architectural services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization.

Rahimuddin S. Rahimi

Case Nos. 2011-046664 & 2011-048465

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs against Rahimuddin S. Rahimi. Rahimuddin S. Rahimi is not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and signed and sealed drawings for a project when an unlicensed individual had the contract.

Scott D. Weinkle

Case No. 2011-020389

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$2,000.00 fine plus costs, reprimand and two years probation costs against Scott D. Weinkle. Mr. Weinkle, a licensed architect, signed and sealed drawings that were not of a sufficiently high standard and failed to perform his legal obligation under the contract because MR. Weinkle should have observed that the spaces were insufficient to properly function as intended.
