Case No. 2015-037503

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed enter a final order imposing a fine of \$1,500.00 plus costs against Rodrigo H. Cadavid. Mr. Cadavid is not licensed to practice architecture and is offering architectural services on his business card.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed enter a final order imposing a fine of \$1,500.00 plus costs against Adriana Cifuentes and Marquis Design Corporation. Ms. Cifuentes and the company are not licensed to practice interior design and contracted to provide interior design services for a veterinary clinic. Further, Ms. Cifuentes is offering these services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order accepting a voluntary relinquishment of Stephen Jones’ license to practice architecture.

Case No. 2018-017104

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs, forty eight hours of continuing education and suspension until compliance against Harvey Koehnen’s license to practice architecture. Mr. Koehnen affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Koehnen was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing costs and reprimand against Phillip Charles Pecord's license to practice architecture. Mr. Pecord had his license suspended for two years and had over \$14,700.00 in fines and costs imposed by the Mississippi Board for failing to exercise responsible supervisory control and aiding unlicensed activity.

David Perkins
Case No. 2018-017091

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs, forty eight hours of continuing education and suspension until compliance against David Perkins's license to practice architecture. Mr. Perkins affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Perkins was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period.
