**Emilio Jose Agrenot  
Emilio Jose Agrenot, P.A.

Probable cause was found that Emilio Jose Agrenot and Emilio Jose Agrenot, P.A. of Miami Lakes, FL, a Florida licensed architect and architectural firm, failed to perform under a contract to provide permit ready drawings even though he was paid in full. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Probable cause was found that Carlos L. Alcalá of Bradenton, FL, a Florida licensed architect, is aiding an unlicensed firm in the offering of architectural services. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Faulkner Eyo

Probable cause was found that Faulkner Eyo of Palm Beach Gardens, FL, a Florida licensed architect, provided six projects during the course of probation which were insufficient. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Eduardo Hillman-Waller

Probable cause was found that Eduardo Hillman-Waller of Coral Gables, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Hillman-Waller was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any of continuing education hours during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Guillermo A. Lugones**  
**Case No. 2016-020262**

Probable cause was found that Guillermo A. Lugones of Hialeah, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Lugones was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any of completing the Building Code course. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.
