Casba Stephen Balazs

Case No. 2012-052767

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing Casba Stephen Balazs's Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Balazs affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Balazs was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period.

David C. Baum

Case No. 2012-052769

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs and completion of the Building Code course against David C. Baum's license to practice architecture. Mr. Baum affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Baum was chosen for the audit and has provided twenty hours of continuing education however he did not take the building code course.

Jerry D'Angelo

Case No. 2012-017816

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$2,500.00 plus costs against Jerry D'Angelo. Mr. D'Angelo is not licensed to practice architecture and is holding himself out as an architect on a website.

Donald A. Dicomio

Case No. 2013-008927

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing Donald A. Dicomio's Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Dicomio affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Dicomio was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period.

Paul A. Donofro

Case No. 2012-052925

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs and completion of forty hours of continuing education against Paul A. Donofro's license to practice architecture. Mr. Donofro affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Donofro was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period.

Faulkner Eyo

Case No. 2011-039332

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing costs against Faulkner Eyo's license to practice architecture. Mr. Eyo initially failed to pay the fines and costs required by a Final Order entered on July 7, 2010 but is now in compliance.

Gilberto Gavarrete

Case No. 2011-035534

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$5,000.00 plus costs against Gilberto Gavarrete. Mr. Gavarrete is not licensed to practice architecture; however he is a licensed Professional Engineer. Mr. Gavarrete signed and sealed plans for a residential project that were prepared by a unlicensed draftsman that entered into a contract for architectural services.

Case Nos. 2012-026888 & 2012-026874

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$7,500.00 plus costs against Carlos H. Gutierrez, Milda Gutierrez and CMGINTG, Inc. Carlos H. Gutierrez, Milda Gutierrez and CMGINTG, Inc. are not licensed to practice architecture and are using the title architect and contracted for architectural services. Further, Mr. and Ms. Gutierrez are offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Jaime Gutierrez

Case No. 2012-027721

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a reprimand and a fine of \$3,000.00 plus costs against Jaime Gutierrez's license to practice architecture. Mr. Gutierrez signed and sealed plans for a project that were prepared by an unlicensed draftsman without ever meeting the client. Further, Mr. Gutierrez has been unable to provide the proper documentation for signing and sealing drawings prepared outside his office.

Harry J. Howard

Case No. 2012-052952

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs, completion of the Building Code course and fifteen hours of continuing education against Harry J. Howard's license to practice architecture. Mr. Howard affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Howard was chosen for the audit and has provided only fifteen hours of continuing education.

Betsy Isackson

Case No. 2012-052954

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$250.00 plus costs and seven hours of continuing education hours against Betsy Isackson's license to practice interior design. Ms. Isackson affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Isackson was chosen for the audit and has provided eighteen hours of continuing education and did not take the building code course.

Roland Martin McFarland

Case No. 2012-052787

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs and eighteen hours of continuing education against Roland Martin McFarland's license to practice architecture. Mr. McFarland affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. McFarland was chosen for the audit and has provided twelve hours of continuing education.

Kristi A. Munilla

Case No. 2012-052925

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs and completion of forty hours of continuing education against Kristi A. Munilla's license to practice interior design. Ms. Munilla

affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Munilla was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period.

Roy D. Murphy

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing Roy D. Murphy's Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Murphy signed and sealed plans for a commercial project that were prepared by an unlicensed draftsman. Further, Mr. Murphy has been unable to provide the proper documentation for signing and sealing drawings prepared outside of his office.

Nandez D & D, LLC

Case No. 2012-028736

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$10,000.00 plus costs against Nandez D & D, LLC and Carlos Hernandez. Nandez D & D, LLC and Carlos Hernandez are not licensed to practice architecture and prepared proposals to provide architectural services for three commercial projects. Further, Mr. Hernandez is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Juan A. Rodriguez-Jomolca

Case No. 2011-018728

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs and two years probation against Juan A. Rodriguez-Jomolca's license to practice architecture. Mr. Rodriguez-Jomolca signed and sealed deficient plans.

Harold Odom

Case No. 2012-052972

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing Harold Odom's Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Odom affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Odom was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period.

Angel C. Saqui

Case No. 2012-052983

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$250.00 plus costs and nine hours of continuing education against Angel C. Saqui's license to practice architecture. Mr. Saqui affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. McFarland was chosen for the audit and has provided fifteen and a half hours of continuing education.
