Lionel Dausa

JM Development Group

Case No. 2010-013465

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$15,000.00 plus costs against Lionel Dausa and JM Development Group. Lionel Dausa and JM Development Group are not licensed to practice architecture and are contracted to provide architectural services. Further, Mr. Dausa is offering these services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization.

Raymond Lee Enfield

Case No. 2010-059153

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing suspension until compliance against Raymond Lee Enfield’s license to practice architecture. Mr. Enfield failed to satisfy the terms of a Final Order that was previously entered on March 8, 2010 by failing to provide proof of continuing education.

Timothy Krebs

Case No. 2009-044158

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a reprimand and costs against Timothy Krebs. Mr. Krebs, a licensed architect, signed and sealed a commercial project for wind load only that was prepared by an unlicensed draftsman. The drawings that were signed and sealed by Mr. Krebs were not of a sufficiency high standard.

David M. Putnam

Case Nos. 2010-005868

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing David M. Putnam's Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Putnam signed and sealed plans for a residential project that were rejected three times. The homeowner was required to hire a new architect whose drawings were approved on the first submittal. The Board's expert consultant reviewed the file and found Mr. Putnam negligent.

Michael D. Tarvin

Case No. 2010-039119

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$5,000.00 plus costs against Michael D. Tarvin. Mr. Tarvin is not licensed to practice architecture and prepared drawings for a commercial project.

Ingrid H. Triplett

Case No. 2010-020088

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs against Ingrid H. Triplett. Ms. Triplett is not licensed to practice architecture and are contracted to provide design services for a residential project and held herself out as an architect.
