Carlos A. Estenoz

Estenoz Engineering, Inc.

Case No. 2011-040667

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$2,000.00 plus costs against Carlos A. Estenoz and Estenoz Engineering, Inc. Carlos A. Estenoz and Estenoz Engineering, Inc. are not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and contracted for architectural services and used the title architect. Further, Mr. Estenoz is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Michael W. Finch

Case No. 2010-047394

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$10,000.00 plus costs against Michael W. Finch. Mr. Finch is not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and contracted to provide architectural services for a commercial project and used the title architect.

Edward Lee Hall

Case No. 2010-037349

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$5,000.00 plus costs against Edward Lee Hall. Mr. Hall is not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and contracted to provide signed and sealed drawings for a commercial project.

Nicole Hollant

Case No. 2010-059274

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing suspension until compliance against Nicole Hollant's

license. Ms. Hollant is a licensed architect and has failed to comply with the terms of a Final Order that was entered on December 1, 2009 by failing to pay a fine and costs in the amount of \$1,156.00.

Hugh S. Wright

Case No. 2011-022101

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs against Hugh S. Wright. Mr. Wright was previously licensed; however his license went delinquent on March 1, 1989 and then into a null and void status on March 1, 1991. Mr. Wright practiced architecture, held himself out as an architect and used his null and void license number.
