AEC Services

Ron Fair

Case No. 2010-034294

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs against AEC Services and Ron Fair. Mr. Fair is a licensed Professional Engineer and entered into a contract to provide architectural services and is using the title Architect. Further, Mr. Fair is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

David E. Beatty

Case No. 2009-019508

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing David E. Beatty’s Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Beatty signed and sealed plans for a residential project without ever meeting with the client.

Further, Mr. Beatty signed and sealed the plans while his license was in a suspended status. The Board’s expert consultant reviewed the plans and determined they were insufficient due to design wind loads.

Jenny Carter

K2 Design Group, Inc.

Case No. 2010-009162

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a reprimand, \$3,000.00 fine plus costs and two years probation against Jenny Carter and K2 Design Group, Inc. K2 Design Group, Inc. has an active certificate of authorization but no longer employs a licensed architect and continues to offer architectural services on its web site.

Jaime P. Colmenares

Case Nos. 2010-012079

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order revoking Jaime P. Colmenares’s Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Colmenares has failed to

comply with the terms of a Final Order that was entered on April 18, 2008, by failing to provide a project list during probation. Further, Mr. Colmenares has failed to pay a fine or provide proof of continuing education pursuant to a Final Order that was entered on March 8, 2010.

Contract Design Group, Inc.
Lynne M. Hawthorne

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a reprimand against Contract Design Group, Inc. and Lynne M. Hawthorne's license to practice interior design. Ms. Hawthorne entered into a contract to perform general contracting, electrical and plumbing services for a residence for which she is not licensed to perform.

Design Team Associates, Inc.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a reprimand against Design Team Associates, Inc. and Carol Green's license to practice interior design. Ms. Green entered into a contract to perform general contracting services for a residence. Ms. Green contracted with an electrical contractor and plumbing contractor as a subcontractor and paid these individuals directly.

Lee Projects, LLC

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$1,500.00 plus costs against Lee Projects, LLC and Gal Levy. Mr. Levy's web site is offering architectural services and appears to have done commercial work. Further, Mr. Levy is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Lynwood G. Willis
Case No. 2010-059290

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order relinquishing Lynwood G. Willis's Florida license to practice architecture. Mr. Willis has failed to comply with the terms of a Final Order that was entered on February 13, 2009 by failing to provide proof of continuing education.
