The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs against Don Stevenson Design and Don Stevenson. Don Stevenson Design and Don Stevenson are not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and offered architectural services through a fictitious name without a certificate of authorization. This is a second offense.

Lesly Gaillard

Case No. 2011-024357

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$5,000.00 plus costs against Lesly Gaillard. Mr. Gaillard is not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and contracted to provide architectural services for a church. The contract specifically offers architectural plans.

Jeffrey Gilger

S. Jeffrey Gilger Design Services, Inc.

Case No. 2011-040956

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$2,500.00 plus costs against Jeffrey Gilger and S. Jeffrey Gilger Design Services, Inc. Jeffrey Gilger and S. Jeffrey Gilger Design Services, Inc. are not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and contracted to provide architectural services on a residential project. Further, Mr. Gilger is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Orestes L. Lopez-Recio

Case No. 2011-019126

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs, reprimand and two years probation against Orestes L. Lopez-Recio. Mr. Lopez-Recio, a licensed architect, entered into a contract to provide permit ready drawings but failed to do so.
