Automated Consulting Services, Inc.

George J. Aubin

Case No. 2013-024361

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$2,000.00 plus costs against Automated Consulting Services, Inc. and George J. Aubin. Automated Consulting Services, Inc. and George J. Aubin are not licensed to practice architecture and are preparing drawings for commercial projects and are offering architectural services without a license. Further, Mr. Aubin is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

David Chernin

Axis Studio, Inc.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$2,000.00 plus costs against David Chernin and Axis Studio, Inc. David Chernin and Axis Studio, Inc. are not licensed to practice architecture and Mr. Chernin is using the title architect, offering architectural services on his website and contracting for architectural services on residential projects. Further, Mr. Chernin is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Theodore W. Estberg

Case No. 2013-014625

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,250.00 plus costs against Theodore W. Estberg’s license to practice architecture. Mr. Estberg has “Don Stevenson Design” on his architectural seal. Don Stevenson is not licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida.

DeAndre Francis

Case No. 2012-040593

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$5,000.00 plus costs against DeAndre Francis. Mr. Francis is not licensed to practice architecture and worked as a draftsman for a licensed architect. Further, Mr. Francis improperly took signed and sealed drawings from a licensed architect he works for, gave them to the client and accepted payment from the client without the knowledge of the architect.

Jeff Travis Johnson

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$250.00 plus costs against Jeff Travis Johnson. Jeff Travis Johnson is not licensed to practice architecture and is preparing drawings for a build out of a day care center.

Lois Ludwig

Case No. 2014-009532

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order accepting voluntary relinquishment of Lois Ludwig's license to practice interior design.

Tina L. Mangiardi

TLM Design & Construction, Inc.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$3,000.00 plus costs against Tina L. Mangiardi and TLM Design & Construction, Inc. Tina L. Mangiardi and TLM Design & Construction, Inc. are not licensed to practice architecture and was offering architectural services. Ms. Mangiardi is using the title architect. Further, Ms. Mangiardi is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

Pamela Manhas

Case No. 2013-039562

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs, forty hours of continuing education and suspension until compliance against Pamela Manhas's license to practice interior design. Ms. Manhas affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Manhas was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$6,000.00 plus costs against Mark D. Sefiner’s license to practice architecture. Mr. Sefiner signed and sealed drawings while his license was in a null and void status. Further, Mr. Sefiner is offering architectural services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization.
