### **I. Unlicensed Cases**

#### **Roland Baker**

##### **Case No. 2011-019040**

Probable cause was found that Roland Baker of Miami, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and entered into a contract to provide architectural services for a church. The contract specifically offers architectural plans. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

#### **Reginald Burton**

##### **Case No. 2011-019047**

Probable cause was found that Reginald Burton of Miami, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and entered into a contract to provide architectural services for a church. The contract specifically offers architectural plans. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

#### **Corner Stone Design Group, Inc.**

#### **Edward P. Tafelski**

##### **2011-010695**

Probable cause was found that Corner Stone Design Group, Inc. and Edward P. Tafelski of San Antonio, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and was paid directly by the client for providing design services on a commercial project. Further, Mr. Tafelski is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

#### **The Cury Group, Inc.**

#### **Edward C. Cury**

##### **Case No. 2011-026912**

Probable cause was found that The Cury Group, Inc. and Edward C. Cury of West Palm Beach, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on its web site. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Cury sign an affidavit stating he has changed his web site and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Cury fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Don Stevenson Design**

**Don Stevenson**

**Case No. 2011-031802**

Probable cause was found that Don Stevenson Design and Don Stevenson of Naples, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services through a fictitious name without a certificate of authorization. This is a second offense. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Lesly Gaillard**

**Case No. 2011-024357**

Probable cause was found that Lesly Gaillard of Miami, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and entered into a contract to provide architectural services for a church. The contract specifically offers architectural plans. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

**Thomas L. Hanson**

**TL Hanson & Associates Consulting Engineers, Inc.**

**Case No. 2011-010709**

Probable cause was found that Thomas L. Hanson and TL Hanson & Associates Consulting Engineers, Inc. of Dade City, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida; however Mr. Hanson is a licensed Professional Engineer. Mr. Hanson was paid by an unlicensed firm to sign and seal drawings for a commercial project. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**The Kirouac Group, LLC**

**Shawn Kirouac**

**Case No. 2011-027213**

Probable cause was found that The Kirouac Group, LLC and Shawn Kirouac of Fernandina Beach, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and entered into a contract to provide architectural services for a residence, walk in clinic and the Savannah Grand. Further, Mr. Kirouac is offering these services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

**Looney & Associates, LLC**

**James Looney**

**Case No. 2012-008115**

Probable cause was found that Looney & Associates, LLC and James Looney of Dallas, TX, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering and providing architectural services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization. This is a second offense. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Metro Architects, Inc.**

**Christopher P. Miller**

**Case No. 2011-024357**

Probable cause was found that Metro Architects, Inc. and Christopher P. Miller of Clearwater, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida. Metro Architects, Inc. was previously issued a citation for offering architectural services on its website without a certificate of authorization. Mr. Miller has failed to pay the citation and is continuing to offer architectural services in the name of Metro Architects, Inc. However, in response to the citation Mr. Miller did add the null and void certificate of authorization number of another business entity known as Metro Architects, LLC. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Rahimuddin S. Rahimi**

**Case Nos. 2011-046664 & 2011-048465**

Probable cause was found that Rahimudin S. Rahimi of Miami Springs, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida. However Mr. Rahimi is a licensed Professional Engineer and signed and sealed drawings for a project when an unlicensed individual had the contract. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Mario H. Rodriguez**

**Case No. 2011-041687**

Probable cause was found that Mario H. Rodriguez of Tampa, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida. Mr. Rodriguez is a recent graduate of the University of South Florida and on a set of drawings Mr. Rodriguez was working on with his professor; he uses the title Project Architect. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from using the title architect was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Rodriguez sign an affidavit stating he will no longer use the title architect in the future. If Mr. Rodriguez fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

### **Turbomouse Drafting Service**

#### **Ryan Kronbetter**

##### **Case No. 2012-004396**

Probable cause was found that Turbomouse Drafting Service and Ryan Kronbetter of Las Vegas, NV, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services in a email. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Kronbetter sign an affidavit stating he has changed his advertising and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Kronbetter fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

### **William Edward Construction, LLC**

#### **David William Boers**

##### **Case No. 2011-061225**

Probable cause was found that William Edward Construction, LLC and David William Boers of Orlando, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and provided drawings for a commercial project and is offering architectural services on its web site. Further, Mr. Boers is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

## **II. Licensed Cases**

#### **Scott D. Weinkle**

##### **Case No. 2011-020389**

Scott D. Weinkle is licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida and it is alleged he signed and sealed drawings that were not of a sufficiently high standard. It is also alleged that Mr. Weinkle failed to perform his legal obligation under the contract because Mr. Weinkle should have observed that the spaces were insufficient to properly function as intended. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.
